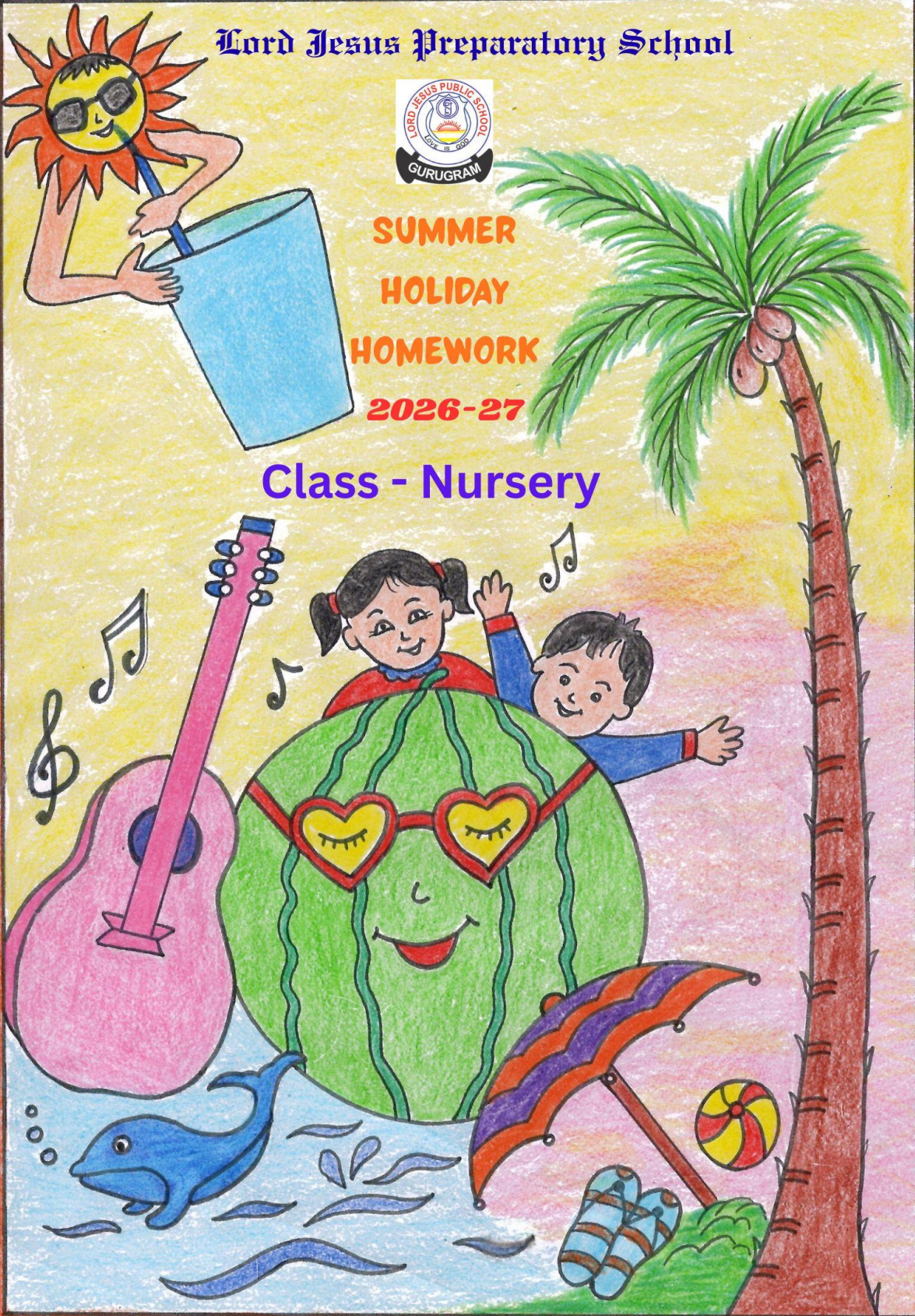




### Little Hands, Big Help!


Encourage your child to take small steps towards independently doing their daily chores.

### **Healthy Habits, Happy Kids!**

- ❖ Brush teeth twice a day (try a brushing song or timer!)
- ❖ Wash hands before and after meals
- ❖ Keep nails trimmed and clean
- ❖ Learn to throw garbage in dustbins

## Communication Skills

Encourage your ward to say:

**Sorry, Please, Excuse me, Thank you !**

Use English vocabulary for day-to-day words instead of mother tongue.

Encourage your child to speak 2–3 sentences daily.

- Revise words through pictures and toys.



Read storybooks together every day.

- Appreciate every small effort to build confidence.

Let's help our little learners express themselves confidently in English. Practice simple phrases like:

\* "May I go to the washroom, please?"

\* "I am feeling hungry."

\* "I have finished my food."

\* "May I drink water?"

\* "Please help me."

Tip - Encourage English conversations at home to help your child become proficient in the language.

## WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY (5 – JUNE)

Activity Name- *DIY Bird Feeder Activity*

*“Feed the Birds, Save Nature”*

**Objective** -Teach children to care for birds and reuse waste materials creatively.

### **Materials Needed**

- Empty plastic bottle or milk carton
- Wooden spoons/sticks
- String or ribbon
- Bird seeds/grains
- Scissors (with adult supervision)
- Colors/stickers for decoration

### **Steps**

1. Clean the bottle/carton.
2. Cut small holes on the sides.
3. Insert wooden sticks to make perches.
4. Fill the feeder with bird seeds.

5. Decorate the feeder using eco-friendly materials.

6. Tie a string and hang it on a tree or balcony.

### **Discussion Points**

- Why are birds important for the environment?
- How does recycling help Earth?
- What can we do daily to protect nature





# Line Concept Craft Activity

## “My Little Hut”

### Learning Objective-

Children will learn:

- Standing lines ,Sleeping lines, Slanting lines through a fun hut-making craft activity.

### • **Materials Required-**

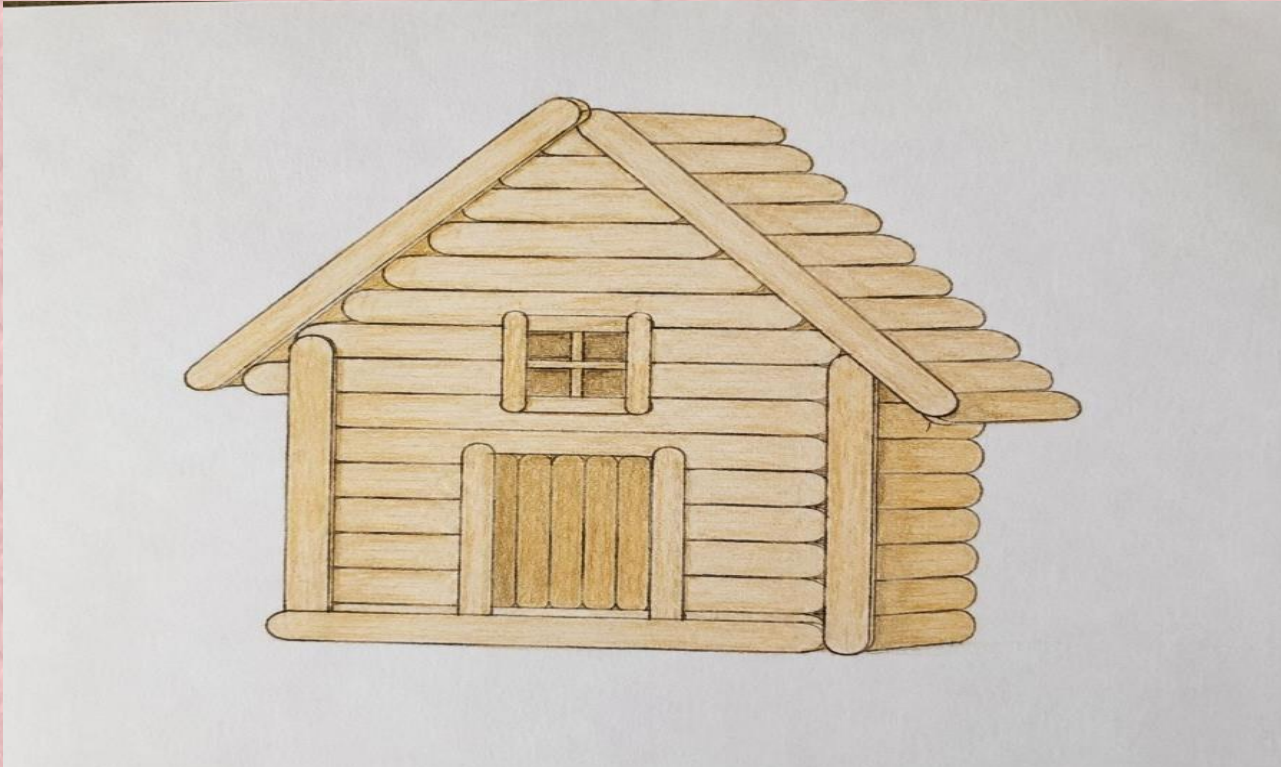
- Ice cream sticks / popsicle sticks
- Glue
- Colored paper or cardboard base
- Sketch pens/crayons
- Scissors
- Decorative items (optional)

### **Instructions**

1. Paste standing lines using vertical ice cream sticks for the hut walls.
2. Use sleeping lines for the base or window design.

3. Make the roof using slanting lines by arranging sticks diagonally.

Do this on A4 size sheet.



### Colorful Hanging Activity

Children have to make any 2 colorful hangings at home using simple craft materials.

Theme ideas:

Clouds

Rainbow

Stars

Sun

Moon

Flowers



Children may use paper, cotton, glitter, ribbons, or recycled materials to create their hangings creatively. Make these hanging in 2D. Size of the hangings should be approx.. 12x12 inches .

### Fine motor skills

Fine motor skills are very important for children's hand strength, writing readiness, and overall development.

We request you to encourage your child to do simple fine motor activities at home such as:

Playing with clay or dough

Tearing and pasting paper

Threading beads

Coloring and drawing

Finger painting

Building blocks and puzzles

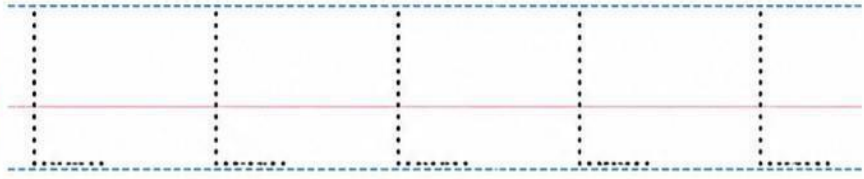
